

play it! 2-in-1 box game



maker checklist

a good sturdy box

wooden dowels or chopsticks

wooden ice cream spoons

small or medium clothespins

paper straws

tape, glue, colorful paper

scissors, hole punch, craft knife

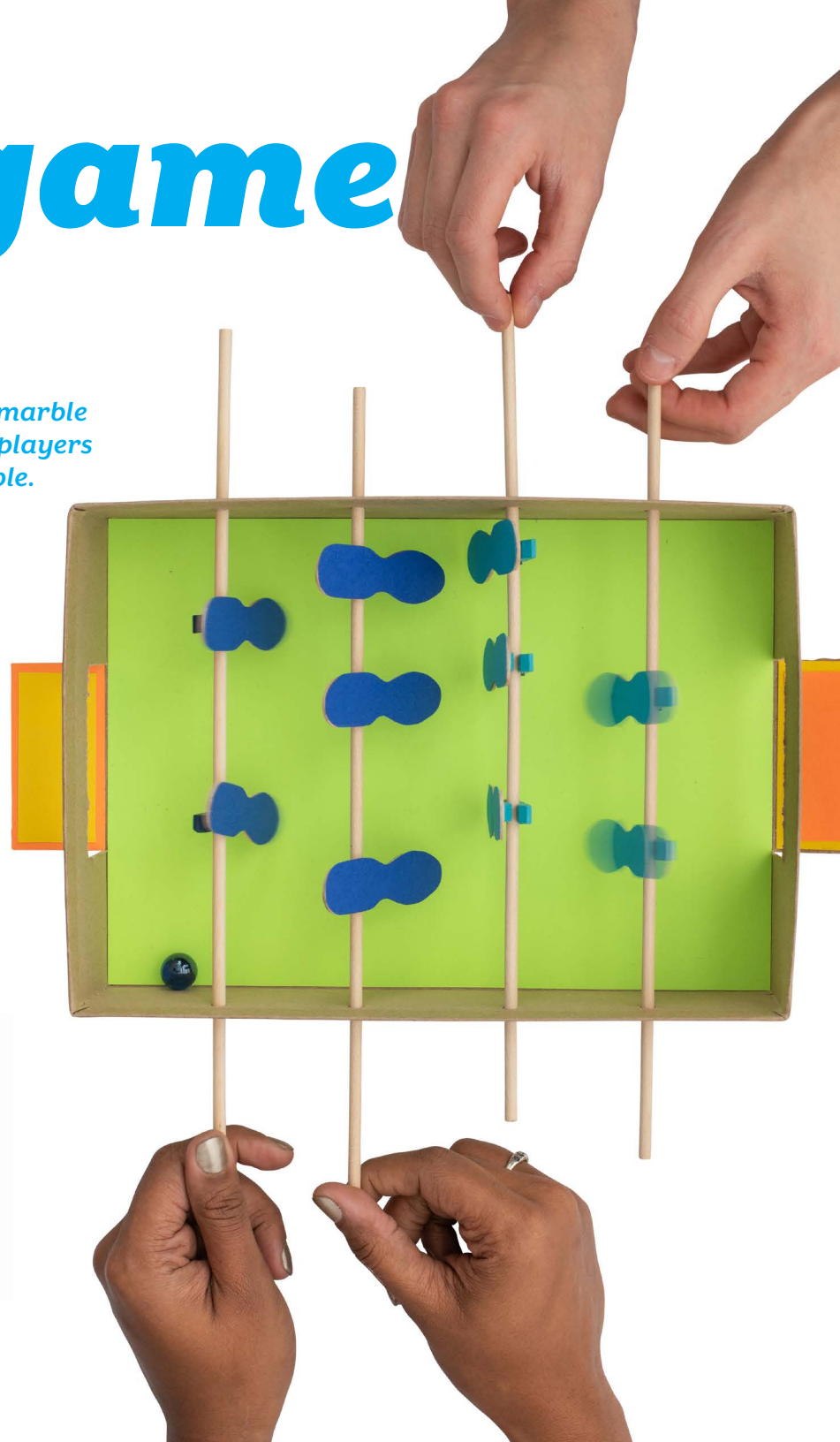
use one half for foosball and the other for the marble maze. start with foosball and make sure your players will "kick" smoothly and contact the marble.

these supplies are what we used, but take this project and make it your own with what you have on hand!

1 make your foosball players by gluing a clothespin to a craft stick or wooden ice cream spoon. then, you can clip them to the dowels.

2 measure and punch holes along the side of a box, to hold the dowels.

3 add a colorful turf and cut goals at the short ends of your box.





1 *plan out your maze, making sure that the pathways are wide enough for your marble!*

2 *trace it lightly in pencil, then cut the paper straws to the lengths, and tape or glue in place.*



3 *set up obstacles, traps or a points and scoring system.*

*pack it up!
now you've got two
games in one box.*
