

stamp it! 6-in-1 cube stamps



maker checklist

- wood cube (1.5" or 2")
- sticky-back craft foam
- scissors + hole punch
- printing inks + brayer
- masking tape
- paper or canvas board



you can create
letter shapes too!



think of patterns like stripes, dots, checkerboard, and spiral, then plan out the 6 designs you want to create. make one for each side of the cube!



FIRST THEN

make your stamp!

create unique patterns for your 6-sided stamp.

cut simple shapes and punch holes from the craft foam, and stick them to the sides of the cube.

make your print!

squeeze a dollop of paint onto a plate or palette. use the brayer to roll out the paint into a thin layer.

press your cube into a paint, then stamp. you can probably get a few stamps out of each application of paint.

layer patterns and colors for an interesting design, or create a word or object.
