

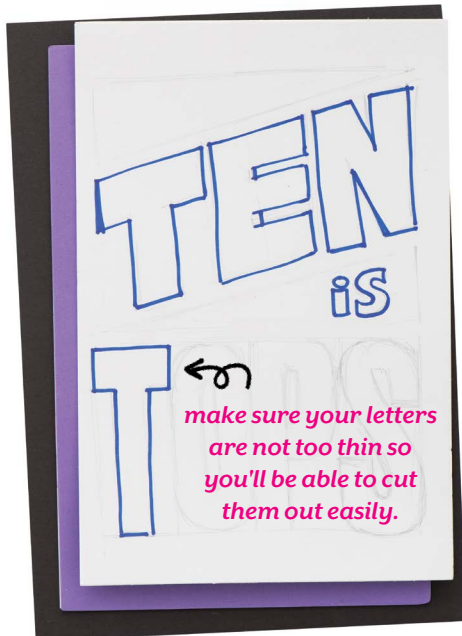
print it! mini poster prints



maker checklist

- pencil, sharpie, scissors
- sheet of foam core (8x10)
- sticky-back craft foam (9x12)
- printing ink and brayer
- bristol or printing paper

HOW TO



1 sketch your design on the white paper side of a sheet of sticky back foam. cut out all the pieces.

peel off the paper backing, and stick your design down on a foam core board.

HERE'S WHERE YOU HAVE TO THINK IN REVERSE!

those letters you drew in the right direction? stick them down in reverse on the board. when you stamp it, they'll be in the right direction again!



2 squirt a little blob of printing ink onto a plate.

use the brayer to roll a thin layer of the ink onto your board, covering the entire design.

once your board is covered with ink, lay a piece of paper on top. do not move or reposition your paper!

3 gently and slowly rub it all over, so the ink transfers evenly to the paper. you can also use a dry brayer to rub the paper.

now carefully peel back the paper (starting at the top corner and holding the board in place) to reveal your beautiful hand-printed poster! and make more!



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
