maker checklist

cube stamp or other stamps
colorful paper
printing or stamping inks
scissors, tape, glue

make your card set

measure and cut colorful paper into flat or folded cards.

engineer envelopes by folding down a large sheet of paper to shape, cutting where needed, and taping or gluing at the seams.

2 stamp + print it!

use your six-sided cube stamp to create a pattern or message and stamp at the top of each card.

stamp the inside flap of the envelopes for extra color and creativity.

no stamp supplies on hand?
here's a work-around! use a jenga block, piece of thin styrofoam and regular markers. etch a pattern into the styrofoam; cut and glue to each side of the jenga piece; color with marker to "ink" it, and print!

use your 6-in-1 cube stamp to create your designs
